The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission reports that coyotes tend to be shy and elusive, but are known to attack pets when on the hunt for food. They can occasionally be spotted alone or in small groups where food is readily available.

#### **Reminders:**

If you have a dog that is prone to incessant barking (especially when you are away or in the morning or evening times)—please be a good neighbor and bring the dog inside and don't let the barking continue. A good rule of thumb would be to be especially conscientious of the noise from your animal prior to 8 a.m. and after 6:30 p.m.! We have many babies in the neighborhood that need their sleep!

Overnight parking on the street is not allowed per our HOA documents—please refrain from leaving cars on the street overnight! We have a narrow roadway and need to maintain clearance for emergency vehicles.

Please attempt to have temporary guests and street parking along the same side of the street if possible—it makes travelling the narrow streets easier for people passing through.

#### **Violation Notices:**

<u>Sunrise continues to conduct drive-through</u> <u>inspections twice a month on Stillwater Circle.</u> Some of the recurring violations include:

- Yards not maintained/weeds/brush
- Driveways/sidewalks/roofs cleaning
- Cars parked along street overnight

If you receive a violation notice, follow instructions and inform management when you will correct the issue. Note that violations not corrected can be corrected by the board and the cost assessed to the homeowner. Please do not let it get to that point.
