

ROADS

- We <u>CONTINUE</u> to have residents exceeding the 20-mph speed limit on the circle. We have more children living in the circle and often times playing in the street. JPD now patrols our streets and will enforce the speed limit.
- Overnight parking on the street is <u>not allowed</u> per our HOA documents—please refrain from leaving cars on the street overnight.
- Be courteous and don't park cars directly across the street from one another. We have narrow roads and need to maintain clearance for emergency vehicles and homeowners to pass through.



PETS

- Please pickup after your dog. Dogs and Cats are under the "leash law" they should NOT be roaming-please walk them on a leash.
- If you have a dog that is prone to incessant **barking** (especially when you are away or in the morning or evening times)—please be a good neighbor and bring the dog inside and don't let the barking continue. A good rule of thumb would be to be especially conscientious of the noise from your animal prior to 8 a.m. and after 6:30 p.m.! We have many babies in the neighborhood that need their sleep.
